**RESOLUTION FOR PROMOTION OF THE LAKE TAHOE BASIN WILDFIRE
AWARENESS MONTH
JULY 2020**

WHEREAS, wildfire poses a threat to the lives and property of the residents and visitors of Lake Tahoe; and

WHEREAS, wildfire has had significant impacts to the Lake Tahoe Basin’s economic and social well-being; and

WHEREAS, Lake Tahoe Basin homeowners could substantially reduce the wildfire threat to their homes and communities by advanced preparation and creation of defensible space; and

WHEREAS, reducing the wildfire threat to homes and communities requires coordinated action between residents, homeowners and local fire agencies, and

WHEREAS, sediment caused by wildfires pose a threat to the water quality of Lake Tahoe; and

We therefore adopt this resolution as a means for education and a call to action to get defensive about wildfire threats; and

We further resolve that Tahoe Douglas Fire Protection District supports the month of July 1, 2020 – July 31, 2020 as Lake Tahoe Basin Wildfire Awareness Month.




